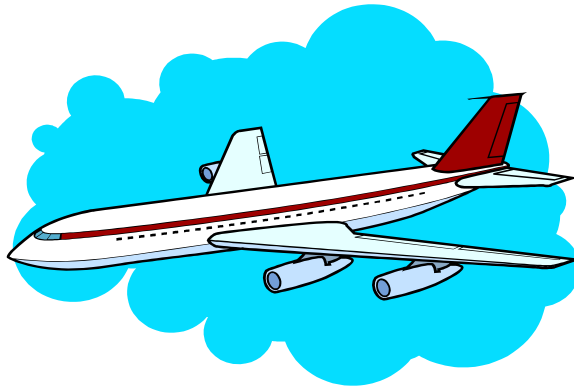

## **AIR CABIN CREW**

### **Is this the right course for me?**

This course has been specifically developed for those seeking a career as Air Cabin Crew. **Thomson Airways** is supportive of the course and will provide a trophy to the student of the year.

### **What will I need to join the course?**

Acceptance will be dependent upon candidates successfully completing an interview.

To be able to qualify for the course you must also be:

- of a good educational standard, with Maths and English GCSEs
- motivated to learn
- well presented
- able to work under pressure
- a team player
- a good communicator
- enthusiastic

### **What will I achieve?**

You will be studying a combination of units designed to give you a broad understanding of Cabin Crew Operations. **Successful completion will result in an interview with Monarch Airlines and BMI British Midland!**

### **Qualifications will include:**

- City & Guilds Level 2 Diploma in Air Cabin Crew
- NVQ Level 1/ 2 Foods and Drink Service
- NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Introduction to Cabin Crew
- Basic Sea Survival
- First Aid
- Foundation Certificate in Wines

- Functional Skills in English and Mathematics

Time will be spent on the course looking at job search methods, filling in application forms, preparing CVs and interview techniques. There will also be guest speakers from airlines, visits to airline training centres, a visit to Norwich airport and an educational visit to a European destination by air.

### **Where will the course be held?**

Lowestoft College.

### **How long will the course last and what patterns of attendance are available?**

The course will run from September to June.

### **How will my progress on the course be assessed?**

The course is assessed by a range of methods including role play, presentations, course work and external assessment.

### **What does it cost? 2011/12**

All fees will be discussed at interview. Students under 19 do not pay tuition or exam fees.

All students will be asked to pay £50 by 30 September as a contribution towards the cost of travel to and from the airports and other educational visits.

In addition, we plan to take all students on a residential trip abroad. This is compulsory and will incur costs if the group is unable to successfully fundraise.

### **And the future?**

Successful completion of the course will place you in a strong position to gain employment as cabin crew or in other travel industry jobs. Many of our past students are now working as cabin crew for a variety of airlines.
