Is this the right course for me?

This course provides the theoretical requirement for students following the Body Massage, Sports Therapy, Aromatherapy and Reflexology courses. It would also be useful to anyone with an interest in the workings of the human body.

What will I need to join the course?

No previous biology or science knowledge is assumed, but the course does require a significant amount of written tests based on the course text book.

What will I be doing?

The course consists of the following modules of study:
The structure and function of all of the systems of the body, including some of their diseases and disorders.

How long will the course last and what patterns of attendance are available?

The course will consist of weekly 2 hour lessons for 30 weeks. A minimum attendance of 80% of lessons is required.

It starts in September and can be attended on:

Thursday 6.15pm – 8.15pm

The course is held at Lowestoft College.

How will my progress on the course be assessed and what will I achieve?

You are required to complete set written tests on each study topic. A study workbook of diagrams and exercises must be completed. A portfolio of all evidence must be produced. A final examination takes place at the end of the course, consisting of a multiple choice theory exam.

NOTE: A pass mark of 70% or better is required to achieve the Diploma. Failure to achieve 70% will result in no qualification being awarded. It is possible to re-sit the exam at a later date if unsuccessful at the first attempt.
