Duration 15 weeks

Evenings -Tuesday &Thursday 6 – 9 pm

This qualification will provide you with a practical introduction to the automotive maintenance and repair industry and covers the main areas of automotive maintenance. This is an introduction qualification which strongly emphasises hands-on assessments in our extensive motor vehicle workshop with an 'on-line' multiple-choice test.

You will study the following:

- Motor vehicle workshop safety
- Introduction to the industry
- Workshop tools and equipment
- Routine cooling and lubrication system checks
- Routine Braking system checks
- Routine wheel and tyre checks

This is an introductory course and there are no formal entry requirements. An interest in motor vehicles and an aptitude for practical skills with the ability to cope with the demands of the course will be expected. Candidates will be interviewed prior to acceptance.
