



VOCATIONAL TRAINING CHARITABLE TRUST L2 CERTIFICATE IN BEAUTY SPECIALIST TECHNIQUES

Is this the right course for me?

This course is for you if you want to work in one of the fastest growing and exciting industries. The units of credit gained during this course are used to gain the full Level 2 Certificate in Beauty Specialist Techniques (QCF). This course provides good opportunities for progression onto further courses of study.

What will I need to join the course?

This course requires a successful interview.

You need to have a good educational background of 3 GCSEs including English and science **or** relevant customer experience and a good personal reference.

It is of the utmost importance that you are a person who takes pride in your appearance and enjoys communicating with people. Enthusiasm, dedication, a mature attitude and competence in the use of the English language are prerequisites of this course.

What will I be doing?

You will be studying a variety of skill units related to Beauty Therapy which include:-

- **Good working relationships with colleagues and clients**
- **Follow health and safety practice in the salon**
- **Provide eyelash and brow treatments**
- **Applied Science – Anatomy & Physiology**
- **Apply make-up**
- **Provide facial skin care**
- **Remove hair using waxing techniques**
- **Salon reception duties**
- **Provide manicure treatments**
- **Provide pedicure treatments**
- **Client care and communication in beauty related industries**

All practical sessions after initial training are client based where the College Salon (Images Beauty Studio) becomes a realistic working environment. Candidates will be expected to assume the role of receptionist and resource assistant during the client session.

How long might the course last and what patterns of attendance are available?

The course will run over **two evenings for 36 weeks on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings 5.30 - 9.15pm**. Both evenings will include study of related Anatomy and Physiology relating to the topic of study.

How will my progress on the course be assessed?

Continuous practical assessments observed by the tutor throughout the year, supported by a professional portfolio of evidence. This will be further supported by external examinations on each unit of study.

What can I achieve?

The Level 2 Certificate in Beauty Specialist techniques
