This course is for anyone who likes people and would like to take the first steps in a career that can open doors worldwide.

#### ***What will I need to join the course?***

Attendance on a compulsory pre-entry short course in July 2012. 2 GCSEs grade D or above in English and Math's required. We also look for enthusiasm, good communication skills, a positive attitude, good personal presentation and motivation to succeed.

Most importantly, a genuine desire to build a firm foundation for a career in the hairdressing industry.
