### **HAIRDRESSING NVQ LEVEL 2 – PART TIME**

#### ***Is this the right course for me?***

This is a professional course in hairdressing for mature students who wish to train for an exciting new career or gain new skills and interests. You should have an interest in people and have good communication skills.

#### ***What will I need to join the course?***

Although there are no formal entry requirements you will need an interview. A personal reference will also be requested. If you have a Hairdressing Level 1 certificate it would be beneficial to you to bring it along to the interview.

Enthusiasm, dedication, a mature attitude and a satisfactory grasp of the English language are a prerequisite of the course. Most importantly, a genuine desire for a career in hairdressing and access to models for assessments.

#### ***What will I be doing?***

Over the two years course of study you will be covering the following subjects:

#### **Level II**

- Unit G20 Make sure your own actions reduce risks to health and safety
- Unit G18 Promote additional products & services
- Unit G17 Give clients a positive impression of yourself and your organisation
- Unit G7 Advise and consult with clients
- Unit G8 Develop and maintain your effectiveness at work
- Unit GH8 Shampoo, condition and treat the hair and scalp
- Unit GH12 Cut hair using basic techniques
- Unit H10 Style & finish hair
- Unit GH11 Set & dress hair
- Unit GH9 Change hair colour

#### ***Optional***

- Unit GH14 Perm and neutralise hair

All practical sessions after initial training are client based where the College Salon 'Images' becomes a working environment. Although every endeavor will be made by the college to provide clients it cannot be guaranteed so you must be prepared to provide models.

#### ***How long will the course last and what patterns of attendance are available?***

Two years, Day/Evening attendance to be confirmed starting at 6pm until 9pm. Times will change through the year due to course requirements, but will start at the same times each session.

Throughout the course you will be assessed by observation of practical skills, written tests, oral questions and assignments.
