Is this the right course for me?

Yes if you are a qualified therapist and wish to gain an additional skill to offer your clients.

What will I need to join the course?

In order to be eligible for the course you need a beauty, complementary or sports therapy qualification, as well as a qualification in Anatomy and Physiology.

What will I be doing?

- The practical techniques covering massage of upper arms, shoulders, neck, scalp and face.
- Essential knowledge of anatomy and physiology, massage routine and relevant business studies.
- Module on monitor and maintain health and safety practice in the salon
- Module on client care and communication in beauty-related industries
- Set home studies for work books and case studies
- A full practical treatment and written assessment to ensure competency

How long will the course last and what patterns of attendance are available?

3 hours per week for 12 weeks on evening to be agreed – 6.15pm-9.15pm
