To gain the qualification you will sit an online multiple choice examination lasting one hour. Results are available almost immediately and on successful completion you will receive your City and Guilds certificate.

### When does the course start and how long does it last?

The course is tailored to your individual needs and is completely flexible so you can join anytime and attend at times that suit you. You will study for 10, 20 or 30 hours depending on your current skills and individual learning needs. These will be discussed during an informal interview with your course tutor.

### Is there a cost?

No- the course (including tuition, exam and certificate) is free to you. **There is a fee to re-sit or re-book tests and this is currently £9.50**
