Is this the right course for me?

This is the course for you if you want to work in one of the fastest growing and exciting industries in the country. The course will provide you with the skills necessary to perform wax treatments to a professional standard and work towards the Diploma in Beauty Specialist Techniques.

What will I need to join the course?

This course requires a successful interview.

You need to have a good educational background of 3 GCSEs including English and Science or relevant customer experience and a good personal reference.

What will I be doing?

Over the course of study you will be covering the following subjects:

Theory and practical of depilation and bleaching with related science.

Level 3 Employment standards and Health & Safety

Client care

Personal presentation

Hygiene procedures

All practical sessions are taken in the college salon (Images Beauty Studio) which is operated as a realistic working environment.

How long will the course last and what patterns of attendance are available?

The course commences in February – May start date to be confirmed.

Monday 6.00 - 9.00 pm and will continue for 12 weeks.

How will my progress on the course be assessed and what will I achieve?

You will need to build a portfolio of evidence (guidance for this will be given). This enables you to show you are competent at a range of tasks over a period of time and will show evidence of every practical skill you have achieved during your period of study.

An external multiple choice paper will need to be passed on Health and Safety and Employment Standards.

You will be assessed continuously throughout practical sessions during which you will be asked questions relating to the task in hand. There will be periodic written tests which provide underpinning knowledge for your portfolio of evidence.
